You will be required to bring the following documentation with you in order that you can be assessed for the Legal Help and Help at Court Scheme:

- Wage slips for the 30 days prior to your appointment if appropriate
- Evidence of any benefits received in the 30 days prior to your appointment
- Evidence of any savings you hold
- Evidence of any other income received in the 30 days prior to your appointment
- Statements for all bank accounts you hold, covering the 30 days prior to your appointment
- Evidence of rent or mortgage that you pay
- Photographic ID (one of the following):
  - Passport
  - Photo Card Driving licence
  - Shotgun certificate with photo
  - Police/Armed Forces ID card
- Proof of address (one of the following):-
  - Utility bill
  - Council Tax demand
  - Bank statement
  - Copy relevant part of electoral roll

We also require the financial information for any partner you are currently residing with, whom the matter you are consulting us about does not involve. We do not require photographic ID or proof of address for your partner.

If you do not qualify for Legal Help there may be a charge for this assessment of approximately £10-15 if you do not wish to obtain advice under my private rates.

If you have received any legal documentation or correspondence, please also bring these documents with you.

Should you not qualify for Legal Help and wish to obtain advice, the fixed fee charging rates are as follows:

Up to 30 minutes	£70.00 plus VAT
Up to 60 minutes	£120.00 plus VAT

After 60 minutes all work undertaken will be charged at the usual hourly rate of £150 plus VAT.
